## 8 & 9 October 2011 Quick Fact Sheet

### The Tag Sale, 9<sup>th</sup> Year!

**Bonus Day! 7 Oct** – Early shopping @ The Antique Flea Market @ Everyday Elegance, 600 E. Main Street gets it started early (10am – 5 pm)

**8 Oct** – Scores of sales throughout Town including three booth sites on Main Street (8am – 3pm) and the Antique Flea Market continues (8am – 5pm)

**9 Oct** – Select sales continue in Town and Town Hall booth lot is open, too! (10 am – 3 pm), The Antique Flea Market is still open (10am – 5 pm)

### Getting to Purcellville, Virginia

We're located about 7 miles West of Leesburg.

*From Points North* – Take Rt 15 S/Rt 340 W from I 70/270; follow Rt 340 W to exit for Brunswick/Rt 17; South thru Brunswick, across the Potomac; follow Rt 287 S

*From Points East* – Take the Dulles Toll Road/ Greenway or Route 7 W to Leesburg; follow Rt 7 W (Bypass) to Purcellville/Rt 287 Exit; take a left off the Exit.

*From Points South* – Take Rt 15 N to Leesburg; Take Rt 7 W (Bypass) to Purcellville/Rt 287 Exit; take a left off the Exit.

*From Points West* – Take Rt 7 E to the Round Hill/Purcellville Exit; follow Business Rt 7 E.

*Coming into Town - From the North, South and East* you can either take a right on Hirst Road then a left on 21st Street (Rt 690) or take a right on Main Street into the heart of Town. *From the West*, you'll be on Main Street entering Town.

### Parking (Look for yellow "Event Parking" signs)

Traffic is congested in the center of Town during the Sale. Recommend parking along W. Main Street or in our designated lots. Quicker and easier! Parking is available on street unless otherwise marked. There are several lots (Valley Shopping Center @ Main St and Maple, 21<sup>st</sup> St. Lot near Train Station, or St Andrew Church (Westside). They all place you an easy walk to booth locations or shuttle stops.

### FREE! Tag Sale Shuttle

*Sponsored by The Shoppes at Main & Maple*

The Western Flyer trolley runs at no cost to ride continuously during Saturday hours along Main Street between St Andrew Church on West Main through Downtown past the booth lots and Train Station to Everyday Elegance (Antique Flea Market site) and the Shoppes @ Main and Maple parking lot. Look for the Shuttle Stop signs or flag it down. Enjoy the Western Flyer Trolley experience!

### Sales Locations

Sales maps are available online the week before the event, in the Purcellville Gazette the week prior to the Sale or at Town Hall info booth during the Sale.

Sales are located throughout the Town. Look for yellow signs directing you to "More Sales" down side streets.

Antique Flea Market (7-9 Oct) – 600 E. Main @ Everyday Elegance across from Bloom.

Booth spaces – Over 65 sellers in several Downtown locations centered on Town Hall and along Historic 21<sup>st</sup> Street.

### Information and Help

Information booth is located at Town Hall (130 E. Main St with detailed maps, local information and assistance. Look for Tag Sale Ambassadors in red smocks to help guide you.

### Bathrooms

Public restrooms or portajohns are available Downtown (Town Hall, Hatcher Lot and Train Station) and at the Antique Flea Market.
